1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0372, dated 27.10.2023, under Sections 379-B, 323 and 411 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.
2. Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner, which is taken on record.
3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition, in the light of the fact that the averment made in the petition to the effect that no recovery was effected from the possession of the petitioner is found to be incorrect as per the record of the Investigating Agency, which has been produced by way of pervi report showing recovery at Sr. No.13 i.e., one mobile phone (Oppo) and Rs.28,000/-.
4. Prayer is accepted.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
