JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to re-issue him passport.
2. Two FIRs came to be registered against the petitioner. The petitioner was convicted in FIR No. 26 dated 26.05.2011 and he was awarded sentence of one year. The petitioner has filed Criminal Revision No. 1202 of 2021 before this Court which is still pending. The trial qua FIR No.49 dated 15.04.2020 is still pending before the trial Court.
3. As per notification No. 570 dated 25.08.1993, in case trial is pending, the applicant may apply to trial Court seeking permission for issuance of passport.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in terms of aforesaid Notification, the petitioner is required to approach trial Court which would decide his application in terms of aforesaid notification.

5. Faced with this situation learned counsel for petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with the liberty to approach trial Court in terms of aforesaid Notification.
6. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
