1. This revision petition is pending for the last 5 years.
2. As per the office report, respondent No.1, 11 and 15 have died but no application to bring their legal representatives on record has been filed.
3. In substance, the petitioner prays that there are as many as 11 cases pending between the parties in which issues are similar. The petitioners want that all these suits should be consolidated before one Presiding Judge as in Assandh, there are only two Presiding Judges holding two different Courts.
4. It is evident from the reading of the impugned order that a transfer application was filed, which was dismissed. Even the Presiding Judges would have been transferred.
5. In view of the aforesaid position, the learned counsel representing the petitioners pray for permission to withdraw the present revision petition in order to file an application for consolidation of all the suits between the parties before one Court.

6. The learned counsel representing the respondents has no objection.
7. Ordered accordingly.
8. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
