N.S. SHEKHAWAT, J.

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation qua the grievance of the petitioner against respondents No.5 to 9, as they had cheated the petitioner to the tune of Rs.3 crores.
2. In compliance of the order dated 20.01.2024, a status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Jatinder Pal Singh, DSP, Dakha, District Ludhiana (Rural) has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 in Court today and the same is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioner had submitted an application to the SSP, Ludhiana (Rural) against the private respondents with a request to register FIR against them. Thereafter, an enquiry was held and it was found that there were monetary transactions between the petitioner and private respondents No.5 to 9. However, no cognizable offence was made out against the private respondents and the

enquiry officer recommended to consign the application filed by the petitioner. Even the said enquiry report has been approved by the SSP, Ludhiana (Rural), as well.

4. In view of the status report filed by learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be issued and the present petition stands disposed of, accordingly. Needless to observe that the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail his alternative remedies, in accordance with law.
