In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that he had raised a claim of medical reimbursement amounting to ₹2,15,905/- but while passing an order on his representation to reimburse the said medical expenditure, only ₹97,455/- has been allowed and no reason has been given as to why, the whole claim cannot be allowed.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that without disclosing any reason by the respondents, the petitioner has not been given the full reimbursement which was claimed.
3. Notice of motion.



4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Learned State counsel after going through the impugned order concedes the factum that no reason has come forward for not allowing the full claim. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the impugned order may kindly be allowed to be withdrawn with liberty to respondents to pass a fresh order giving reasons for the decision arrived at qua the claim raised by the petitioner for the medical reimbursement.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the fact that the impugned order has been withdrawn with liberty to pass a fresh order, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.
