1. This revision has come up for actual hearing after 4.3.2015.
2. In the last order dated 4.3.2015, it is mentioned that petitioner is reported to have died. Mr. N.S. Rapri, Advocate appeared on his behalf and sought time to implead his LRs.
3. As per report of the Registry Mr. H.L. Bhatia, Advocate and Mr. N.S. Rapari, Advocate through whom the petitioner had filed the revision petition have since passed away.
3. Copy of the notice is also placed on record, wherein the Process Server has made the report that son of Mr. H.L. Bhatia, Advocate reported that his father had died and similarly the Process Server has given the

report that as per inquiries, he came to know that Advocate has since passed away.

- 4. As per office note, Mr. Sandeep Chabbra, Advocate for the respondent has been notified through telephonically, but despite call, there is no representation on his behalf.
- 5. In view of the aforesaid facts whereby the petitioner and his counsel have expired and in the last order recorded on 4.3.2015, Mr.N.S. Rapri, Advocate has taken adjournment to implead LR's of deceased-petitioner, but no application for bringing on record was moved since then. In these circumstances, this Court has no other option but to dismiss the petition.
- 6. Ordered accordingly.
- 7. In case, anyone appears on behalf of the petitioner, he will be at liberty to revive the present petition.
