1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr. P.C with a prayer to handover the investigation in a complaint No. 39980CD1 dated 23.08.2023 to some independent Investigating Agency.
2. A short reply by way of an affidavit of Commissioner of Police, Amritsar has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and the same is taken on record.
3. Learned State counsel submits that after holding enquiry, one FIR No.12 dated 01.02.2024, under Sections 419,420,465,467,471,511,120B of IPC, Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar has already been registered against Jagtar Singh Boxer, Gurdarshan Singh, Maninder Singh Namberdar, Rupinder Kaur Namberdar, Ashwani Kumar @ Ashu, Deed Writer and Dharam Parkash, Advocate.

4. Learned State counsel further submits that two accused have already been arrested in the present case and attempts are being made to arrest the remaining accused also, against whom sufficient evidence has been collected by the police. He has further assured the Court that a Senior Officer shall be deputed to investigate the present case.
5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the petition is accordingly, disposed off.
