Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner is ready and willing to submit himself to the jurisdiction of the learned trial Court and face the trial. The offence in which the FIR is registered is bailable.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab puts in appearance on receipt of advance notice of the present petition.

The sole purpose of issuance of non-bailable warrants is to secure the presence of the accused before the trial Court. The petitioner in the present case has himself come forward and has undertaken to appear before the learned trial Court on each and every date.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The impugned order dated 09.11.2023, vide which, bail bonds of the petitioner were cancelled and forfeited to State, is set aside. The petitioner is directed to appear before the learned trial Court within two weeks from the receipt of this order and on his doing so, the learned trial Court shall admit him to the bail on his furnishing fresh bail bonds/surety bonds along with Rs.10,000/- as costs, for wasting the precious time of the Court to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Hoshiarpur.
