1. Petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for challenging order, Annexure P-1, whereby his application for grant of Arms License has been rejected.
2. Counsel has been heard. He does not dispute that the petitioner has a remedy of challenging the order before the Appellate Authority under Section 18 of the Arms Act, 1959.
3. In view of the above, petition is dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the Appellate Authority in accordance with law.
