SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner submits that prayer for preponment of the main petition be entertained and since he does not wish to pursue the main petition which is otherwise listed for 07.05.2024. He further submits that at the time of the filing of the instant application No. CRM-16028-2024, he missed out the prayer for preponment of the main case itself.

Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner as well as the arguments that private respondents have resiled from the compromise as on date and in that eventuality statements could not recorded before the Illaqa Magistrate in pursuance to the order dated 22.01.2024 passed by this Court.

This Court is sanguine of the fact that no purpose would be served by keeping the petition pending. Presence of the complainant-

respondent is not required for deciding the instant prayer made in the present application, since no prejudice would be caused to them.

Notice of the application to respondent/State.

Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab, having served with an advance copy accepts the same on behalf of respondent/State and states that he has no objection in case the present application is allowed and the main petition is preponed to today.

In view of the above, the present application is allowed and main case i.e. CRM-M-2986-2024 is preponed to today.

The main case is taken on Board. An application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved to withdraw the main petition via CRM-16028-2024.

In the light of submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and having perused the averments made in the application apart from no objection given by respondent-State, the prayer is accepted.

The petition is accordingly ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
