1. The present petition emanates from a landlord and tenant dispute.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submit that vide order dated 20.07.2023, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Pursuant thereto, the parties have amicably settled their *inter se* disputes vide settlement/compromise dated 01.12.2023 recorded by the learned Mediator and in compliance whereof, respondent-tenants have handed over the vacant possession of the demised premises to the petitioner on 30.03.2024
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner acknowledges the aforesaid and states that in view of the same, nothing survives for adjudication in the

present revision petition, the dispute having been amicably settled by way of alternate dispute resolution (ADR).

4. In view of the above, learned counsel for the parties submit that hearing of main revision be preponed and the same be disposed of in terms of settlement/compromise dated 01.12.2023.
5. On the oral prayer of learned counsel for the parties, hearing of main revision is preponed to today and with their consent, same is taken on board.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the terms recorded under Clause 7 (vi) of the aforesaid settlement/compromise, he prays for withdrawal of the present petition.
7. Dismissed as withdrawn.
8. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
