Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in criminal case having FIR No.111 dated 03.07.2023 registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

2. As per the allegations appearing in the FIR, co-accused Gurpreet Singh caused grievous injury with the help of datar on left elbow of complainant while lalkaras, kick and fist blows are attributed to the present petitioners.
3. The petitioners were granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation by this Court vide order dated 18.01.2024.
4. Counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners submits that only simple injuries are attributed to the petitioners and the petitioners joined investigation with the police in compliance of the previous order.
5. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Charanjit Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by counsel for the

petitioners and further submits that the petitioners are not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation and recovery of wooden dandas used by petitioners in commission of crime is already effected.

6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 18.01.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
