1. Instant petition under Section 482 Cr.PC has been preferred seeking directions to respondents No. 1 and 2 to inquire the matter in question in the light of application dated 05.01.2024 (Annexure P-7) and investigation report dated 02.07.2022 (Annexure P-2) and further taking action against respondent No. 6, who is illegally harassing the petitioners.
2. Heard.
3. It is, *inter alia*, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that at the instance of respondent No. 6, the police officials are unnecessarily harassing the petitioners repeatedly. He submits that even the inquiries have been conducted twice, once by the Economic Wing and the other by SHO, P.S. Sector 32-33, Karnal-respondent No. 3. He further submits that, in this regard, the petitioner had moved the representation

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dated 05.01.2024 before the Superintendent of Police, District Karnal, but no action has been taken on the said representation.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

6. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Karnal, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 05.01.2024 (Annexure P-7), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners.

9. Disposed of.
