Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents to make the proper arrangement of rain water which is accumulated in the fields of the petitioners and caused damage to the crops of the petitioners as well as other villagers of Village Gagra, despite the order dated 05.12.2023 passed by this Court wherein the respondent-State through their detailed reply deposed that corrective measures shall be taken by laying down pipe in order to properly drain the accumulated water and still has failed to comply with the directions passed by this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that though the petitioners have earlier approached this Court by way of filing of CWP-11215-2019, which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 05.12.2023. It has been submitted that the respondent-authorities have not complied with the directions given by this Court vide order dated 05.12.2023.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, it is apparent that this Court has already dealt with the grievances now raised by the petitioners in CWP-11215-2019, which was disposed of on 05.12.2023 and thus, the present petition is dismissed being not maintainable.

However, in case the petitioners are aggrieved, they are at liberty to pursue their remedy as available to them in accordance with law.
