Although statement of both the parties in compliance of order dated 19.01.2024 have been received but learned counsel for the respondent No.2- complainant submits that disputes have again arisen amongst the parties due to which compromise has not been finalised.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he has similar instructions to the effect that dispute between the parties still subsists.
