1. After receiving express instructions from his client, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to the grievance raised through the present petition the petitioner shall make an application to the Grievance Redressal Committee (for short, the Committee) constituted on 10.12.2023 by the Consortium of National Law Universities and that he would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Committee to take an expeditious decision on the aforesaid application to be made by the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the contesting respondent No.4 submits that he has no objection if the afore alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted.

3. In the aforesaid circumstances the present petition is disposed of by permitting the petitioner to take up the grievance raised in the present petition through filing of an application before the Committee and since the petitioner seeks admission to the B.A. LL.B. course, if the application, the permission for which has been sought and got through the instant order, is made by the petitioner, the Committee is requested to expeditiously consider and dispose of the same, in accordance with law.

Needless to add that while taking its decision the Committee shall be uninfluenced by the contents of the e-mail dated 09.01.2024 sent to the petitioner by the CLAT team.
