1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for violation of order dated 05.03.2019 passed by this Court in CWP 4530-2019.
2. Counsel for the respondents while referring to affidavit of Shri Rajesh Yadav, Executive Engineer, Project Division No. 1, Irrigation and Water Resources Department, Haryana, Panchkula submits that the order qua which the contempt is asserted; has since been complied with and the petitioner has been allowed to join the service.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the factual position.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if the grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
