1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking directions to the official respondents to extend benefit of step up of pay in terms of letter dated 22.08.2019 (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that he has served legal notice dated 18.10.2023 (Annexure P-4) upon the respondents and till date no action has been taken on it by the respondents.
3. Learned State counsel, who on advance notice is present in Court, assures the Court that legal notice of the petitioner would be decided expeditiously.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees with the aforesaid arrangement.

5. In the wake of statement of learned counsel for both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide legal notice of the petitioner within six weeks from today.
