ANIL KSHETARPAL, J

1. The First Appellate Court has appointed a Local Commissioner to demarcate the suit property in order to find out as to whether the same is within the territorial jurisdiction of the village Fatehpur or within the municipal limits of Pundri.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the suit filed by the petitioner for the grant of decree of permanent injunction was decreed and the First Appellate Court erred in appointing the Local Commissioner.

3. This court has considered the submissions of the learned counsel representing the petitioner.

4. Before deciding the dispute, the court is required to be equipped with all the material which enables the Court to decide the matter effectively. In this case, the Local Commissioner has been appointed to demarcate the suit property in order to know whether the property is situated in the territorial jurisdiction of the village Fatehpur or within the municipal

limits of Pundri.

- 5. The learned counsel representing the petitioner has failed to show any prejudice caused to the petitioner.
- 6. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and discussion, no ground to interfere is made out.
- 7. Dismissed.
- 8. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
