1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 151 CPC for setting aside the order dated 20.02.2017 (Annexure P-5) passed by the District Judge, Tarn Taran vide which the amount of Rs.8,000/- has been fixed as maintenance pendente lite.
