1. This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.
2. Heard.
3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that feeling aggrieved by the acts and conduct of the private respondents, the petitioners have moved a representation dated 12.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) before the Director General of Police, Punjab and Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, but no action has been taken thereon.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3 to consider and

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dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

- 5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.
- 6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gurpreet Singh Sandhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.
- 7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3-the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 12.01.2024 (Annexure P-2), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.
- 8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners.
- 9. Disposed of.
