The prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.5 who is harassing the petitioner with demands of immoral favours and is threatening her to implicate the petitioner in a false criminal case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the from the last two months, respondent No.5-ASI Mohinder, who is incharge of Police Post Kulhan under the jurisdiction of P.S. Sadar Tohana had started raiding the house of the petitioner during odd hours. He had visited the house of the petitioner several times during midnights without accompanying any lady police official and each and every time, he misbehaved with the petitioner in front of her minor children and asked for the immoral favours. He further submits that when the petitioner has raised an objection, respondent No.5

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threatened the her to implicate her in a false criminal case and in this regard, she has already made a representation dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-3) for seeking protection of her life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Ms. Geeta Sharma, DAG, Haryana puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents No.1 to 4-State and copy of the petition has been supplied in the Court.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
