1 Present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking mandate to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his wife as he claims harassment at the hands of the police authorities for the reason that his son is allegedly found to be involved in cases under NDPS Act.

2 Status report by way of affidavit of Satvinder Singh Virk, PPS, DSP Jagraon, District Ludhiana (Rural) on behalf of respondents No.1, 2, 4 & 5 has been filed. The same is taken on record. The relevant para thereof reads as under :-

“10. That accused Harjinder Singh @ Rindi is son and accused Sukhwinder Kaur is daughter in law of petitioner Karnail Singh. Accused Sukhwinder Kaur is absconding to avoid her arrest in this case. The answering respondents did not harass or humiliate the petitioner and his wife. The petitioner and his wife were not called by the police in the

police station. There is no danger to the petitioner and his wife from the police of PS Sidhwan Bet. All these are false allegations leveled by the petitioner on the police officials in order to help his son Harjinder Singh @ Rindi and daughter in law Sukhwinder Kaur. The petitioner Karnail Singh and his wife are not wanted to the police of PS Sidhwan Bet in the present case or any other case at present.”

3 Keeping in view the positive stand taken by the police authorities that neither the petitioner nor his wife has anything against them and therefore, there is no requirement of petitioner and his wife. No further order by this Court is warranted.

4 Present petition is disposed off accordingly.
