Prayer in the instant application filed under Section 151 of
CPC is for placing on record reply filed on behalf of respondent No.7.

Allowed as prayed for.

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1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the official respondents not to replace the petitioners with the daily wagers or with the similar another employees in the absence of regular employee.

2. Short reply on behalf of respondent No.7 has been filed, wherein it has been stated as under :-

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4. *That it would be appropriate to mention that the answering respondent never snatched the keys of the tubewell rooms from the petitioners, rather they made a false ground to get the relief from this Hon’ble Court. Now the petitioners are operating their respective tubewells and the Gram Panchayat is not intended to replace them with any other employee or person, if they work properly, diligently and satisfactorily. As such the present petition is liable to be dismissed on this score alone.*
