1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of first and second Assured Career Progression Scheme (ACP) to the petitioner from the date of his entitlement and release all the arrears thereof together with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was entitled for grant of Assured Career Progression Scheme (ACP), which has been so mentioned in the head note of the present writ petition and in this regard, he had served a representation dated 11.09.2023 (Annexure P-11) to respondent No.2-Managing Director, Haryana State Warehousing Corporation, Sector-2, Panchkula, Haryana but the same has not been considered and decided till date.

He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the

aforesaid representation dated 11.09.2023 (Annexure P-11) is considered and decided by respondent No.2-Managing Director, Haryana State Warehousing Corporation, Sector-2, Panchkula, Haryana in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. He submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, he has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Managing Director, Haryana State Warehousing Corporation, Sector-2, Panchkula, Haryana to consider and decide the representation dated 11.09.2023 (Annexure P-11) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
