1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 10 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 02.11.2023 passed in CWP-24583-2023.
2. Affidavit of Ajay Singh Tomer, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Fatehabad, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 02.11.2023 passed in CWP-24583-2023 has since been complied with and the legal notice of the petitioner has been decided by passing a speaking order dated 13.02.2024 (Annexure A-1).
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
