1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the juniors of the petitioner are getting more salary than the petitioner including respondent No.3 hence, the petitioner is entitled for salary as being paid to respondent No.3.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that seniority list of the Master/Mistress was being revised and the same has already been finalized in August 2020 and the claim of the petitioner will be considered keeping in view the fresh seniority list and in case, it is found that any of the person junior to the petitioner is getting higher salary than the petitioner, the benefit of step up of pay will be granted to the petitioner otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order, which will be passed

within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order giving the details as to why the petitioner is not entitled for the benefit.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
