1. Prayer in this revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is for setting aside the common award dated 03.09.1998, whereby bunch of seven claim petitions was disposed of.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the instant revision petition was admitted vide order dated 30.11.1998 and ordered to be heard along with FAO-1472-1996. He has produced on record copy of judgment dated 22.10.2016 disposing of the aforesaid appeal along with the bunch of other connected appeals.
