The appeal bearing No.CRA-203-2018, titled as “***Subhash Chand v. Satyawvan Raghav***” against conviction filed by the petitioner was pending before learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Gurugram.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though, the petitioner was present in the morning hours on 13.10.2023, but in the after lunch sessions, due to some personal circumstances, petitioner could not appear and his bail was cancelled.

3. However, perusal of the order dated 13.10.2023, whereby bail of the petitioner was cancelled, speaks volumes about the conduct of the petitioner as is duly reflected in the impugned order. Anyhow, since it is the first default on the part of the petitioner, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the Appellate Court concerned on or before 15.02.2024. On his such surrender, the Appellate Court shall initiate the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. against the petitioner and after disposal of those proceedings, shall grant bail to him. Till the disposal of the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C., the petitioner shall not be taken into custody. If in the meantime, due to issuance of warrants of arrest against the petitioner, he

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is sought to be arrested, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.
