RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 28.07.2023 passed in CRWP-7436-2023.
2. Compliance affidavit of Daljinder Singh Dhillon, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Pathankot, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 28.07.2023 passed in CRWP-7436-2023 has since been complied with and representation of the petitioner has been decided by passing a speaking order dated 13.01.2024 (Annexure R-1).
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
