The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in case bearing FIR No. 188 dated 15.12.2023, under Section 379 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

[2] Learned State Counsel, on instructions from the quarter concerned, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of order dated 19.01.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.
