Prayer in the present petition is for directing the official respondents No.3 to 5 to return the licenced revolver along with 20 live cartridges of the petitioner.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly concedes that in the interregnum, the licence itself has been cancelled.

In view of above, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous at this stage and is disposed of accordingly. The liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to pursue his remedy in accordance with law against the subsequent decision of the respondents cancelling the armed licence issued to him.
