On 20.01.2024, the following order was passed by this Court:-

*“By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in a case arising out of FIR No.431 dated 01.10.2023, under Section 304-A IPC (Section 304-A IPC deleted and Section 304 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Kheri Pul, District Faridabad, Haryana.*

*As per allegations, a lad Ajay was found dead at a swimming pool. Said swimming pool was owned by petitioner Tejveer, who had leased out the same to Aman.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the only allegation against the petitioner is that no safety measures was provided at the swimming pool nor safety jackets were available. Learned counsel contends further that this itself does not attract Section 304 IPC*

*Notice of motion.*

*Mr. Parveen Kumar Aggarwal, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.*

*Adjourned to 01.03.2024 for filing status report.*

*In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. He will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to*

*the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”*

Today, it is informed by learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Aayub Khan, that in compliance of the order dated 20.01.2024, petitioner has since joined the investigation and he is no longer required for any investigation.

In view of the afore-said statement, order dated 20.01.2024 whereby interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner in the FIR in question, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer and make compliance of the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
