1. Learned counsel submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous on account of the fact that two claims of the petitioners stand admitted, however, as regards the arrears is concerned, a representation dated 07.07.2020, Annexure P-44 has been submitted by them, but the same has not evoked any response. He thus, at this stage, on instructions from the petitioners, prays that a direction be given to the respondents to decide the same by taking note of the instructions dated 25.04.2019, Annexure P-37 in a time bound manner.
2. Written statement has been filed by learned counsel for UOI, which is taken on record. In so far as the submission aforesaid is made, he on instructions states that the same shall be decided within a period of 2 months.
