1. In compliance of the order dated 20.01.2024, the petitioner as well as respondents No. 5 and 6 are present in the Court. Respondent No. 6 who is present today in Court along with his mother has stated that they were not aware about the act and conduct of the petitioner No.1 as they had gone to Gorakhpur (Uttar Pradesh) and then came to Chandigarh on 21.01.2024 and all the allegations in the petition are false and frivolous.
2. The petitioners have interacted with respondents No. 5 and 6 and submitted that they have no threat perception at this stage.
3. Without commenting on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners and change of religion by petitioner No. 1, it is made clear that the filing of this petition or any order passed herein shall not be a ground available to them for any further relief, as the said marriage has not been solemnized under the Special Marriage Act. However, considering the above facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of and respondent No. 3 shall

ensure that no untoward incident takes place and peace and harmony of the society is maintained.

4. Since respondent No.5 who is the mother of the petitioner has come all the way from Gorakhpur (Uttar Pradesh) and at this stage, she has requested that she be permitted to meet her daughter-petitioner No. 1, to which petitioner No. 1 has agreed that she will meet her mother today itself. However, as a matter of abundant precaution, the petitioner shall inform the concerned SHO before meeting respondent No.5 and both the parties shall not disturb the peace and harmony of the society and shall amicably try to resolve the matter.

5. It is made clear that filing or pendency of this petition or any order/direction passed in this petition shall not be an *alibi* or defence to the petitioners, in case, they are found involved in any illegal activity and/or in violation of any law qua which the competent-authorities or the State shall take appropriate action, in accordance with law.
