The grievance of the petitioner is that though her marriage with respondent No.2 was solemnized way back in November 2005 and she has two children out of that wedlock, but since the date of marriage she was being tortured by respondent No.4, who is a drug addict. Petitioner complained to her family members several times, but they did not support her. Petitioner came under depression and had to take treatment from Godrej Hospital. Compelled by the circumstances, petitioner left the company of respondent No.4 and joined the company of her friend Sahib Singh S/o Shankar Singh, R/o Village Bhail Dhaiwala, Tehsil and District Tarn Taran, with whom she is presently residing without any pressure.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner categorically submits that it is not a case of live-in relationship and that the petitioner has taken refuge from her friend, but she is now being threatened to be eliminated by the private respondents.

3. Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only.

4. Mr. Karunesh Kaushal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3-State.

5. After hearing learned counsel of both the sides, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to look into the representation made by the petitioner to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran (Annexure P-2) and asses the threat perception to her life and liberty and provide necessary protection to her, as per requirement.
