1. The instant application has been filed for impleading the legal heirs of petitioner Balwinder Singh, who is the legal heir and son of Gurdev Singh.

2. It is apt to mention here that this Court has made a final verdict upon the instant writ petition on 16.12.2023, when petitioner-Balwinder Singh was alive. Thereafter, the petitioner-Balwinder Singh filed SLP before the Hon'ble Apex Court on 23.12.2023 against the afore verdict. However, the said Balwinder Singh died on 26.12.2023.

3. Therefore, when the death of petitioner-Balwinder has occurred post the making of final verdict, upon, CWP-3903-2005, by this Court and after his filing a SLP before the Hon'ble Apex Court. Thus, the instant application cannot be allowed by this Court, and, is as such
