1. By way of present petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 read with Section 2(b) of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, contempt proceedings are sought to be initiated against the respondent towards alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 11.09.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-13913-2023.
2. Short reply filed by way of affidavit of Mahesh Kumar, Sub-Divisional Officer (Civil)-cum-Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Bhiwani on behalf of respondent in the Court today, is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.
3. Learned counsel representing the respondent on instructions submits that a fresh demarcation as per Masavi shall be conducted within a period of 7 days from today and a report thereof shall be forwarded to the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of. Rule stands discharged.
5. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned



period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
