By way of this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner had prayed to quash the order dated 13.03.2012 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Hisar, in a criminal complaint No.3461 of 2006, titled as **“The Indian National v. H.L. Kaul”**, and the subsequent proceedings.

2. On 03.03.2021, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Although learned counsel for the petitioner in his arguments has raised challenge to order dated 05.03.2012, declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender, yet there is no prayer in the petition to said order.

Faced with the aforementioned position, learned counsel for the petitioner requests for an adjournment to amend the petition.

List as and when needful is done.”

3. Today, the matter has been listed as per directions of the authorities. Till date, no application has been moved by the petitioner for challenging the order. It is despite the fact that counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Gorang Gupta has been duly informed through e-mail, as reported by the Registry. 4. In the aforesaid circumstances, present petition is hereby dismissed for want of prosecution.

It is hereby made clear that no interim stay regarding proceedings
before the Trial Court was ever granted in this case.
