1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobedience of the order dated 12.04.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-2255-2023.
2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and has produced copy of order dated 28.09.2023 passed by the respondent. The same is taken on record. Learned State counsel has submitted that the order dated 12.04.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-2255-2023 has been complied with and the benefit of notional pay fixation and seniority at par with her junior have been granted to the petitioner.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
