1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 09.11.2023 passed in CWP-25366-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 09.11.2023 passed in CWP-25366-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 19.02.2024 has been passed.
