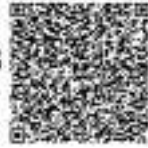

The first application has been filed for impleading the applicants as respondents No.4 to 15 and the second application has been filed for placing on record the written statement on behalf of the proposed respondents No.4 to 15.

For the reasons mentioned in the applications, the same are allowed subject to all just exceptions.

The applicants are ordered to be impleaded as respondents No.4 to 15. The amended memo of parties as well as the written statement filed on their behalf is also ordered to be taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place of the paper book.

The impleadment of respondents No.4 to 15 shall, however, be for the purpose of pursuing present petition only and without prejudice to the rights of any third person/party.

MAIN CASE

Challenge in the present petition is to the impugned order dated 04.07.2023, whereby the District Registrar of Societies, Faridabad had recorded that the tenure of the Governing Body of the Society has come to an end and an *ad-hoc* committee had been appointed which initiated the process of election.

Learned counsel for respondents No.4 to 15 has informed that the present petition has become infructuous since the instant writ petition had been filed on behalf of the petitioner organization through Shri S.S. Malik, who had also preferred Appeal No.652 of 2024 under Section 79 of the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012 against the new Governing Body as well as the declaration of result of election held on 14.01.2024 alongwith the approval granted on 27.02.2024. He contends that the petitioner has been granted liberty to pursue the petition under Section 40 of Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012 filed by him which is now stated to be pending before the District Registrar of Firms and Societies, Faridabad.

In view of the subsequent developments in the matter including the recourse taken by the petitioner as mentioned above, I find that the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

The questions of law as raised herein are, however, kept open. The petitioner is at liberty to take all pleas available to him before the Competent Authority concerned.

All other misc. application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
