This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 17.10.2023 passed in CWP-16852-2023.

Learned counsel for the respondents has produced copy of letter dated 07.03.2024, vide which, necessary action has been taken and the petitioner has been called for making necessary corrections, as required under the order passed by the Writ Court.
