Affidavit of Shri Manavjit Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Tapa, has been filed on behalf of the respondent- State, in compliance of the previous order.

On 20.01.2024, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in a case arising out of FIR No.57 dated 28.06.2022, under Section 379B IPC, registered at Police Station Tapa Mandi, District Barnala.

As per allegations, snatching of mobile was committed by co-accused Paras Singh and Gauri Singh alongwith one unidentified persons on 26.06.2022 from the complainant Gurdeep Singh.

It is alleged that petitioner has been nominated as an accused by the co-accused vide Rapat No.17 dated 22.08.2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated after more than one year of the alleged date of occurrence. Learned counsel contends further that petitioner has no criminal antecedent and that he is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Karunesh Kaushal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

Adjourned to 01.03.2024 for filing status report.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. He will not leave the country without prior permission of

the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Today, it is informed by learned State Counsel, that in compliance of the order dated 20.01.2024, petitioner has since joined the investigation and he is no longer required for any investigation.

In view of the afore-said statement, order dated 20.01.2024 whereby interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner in the FIR in question, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer and make compliance of the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
