The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.260 dated 19.11.2022 under Sections 436, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar (Rural).

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 14.03.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 14.03.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 14.03.2024 is made absolute.

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However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
