1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in case bearing FIR No.58 dated 07.11.2023 registered under Sections 307, 341, 323, 324, 148 & 149 IPC at P.S. Cheema, District Sangrur.
