1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 2(b) read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 15.12.2023 passed in CWP-28207-2023.
2. Affidavit of Sartaj Singh Cheema, District Controller, Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Amrtisar, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 15.12.2023 passed in CWP-28207-2023 has been complied with and representation of the petitioner has been decided by passing the necessary order.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
