**RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)**

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 05.07.2023 passed in CWP-24918-2015.
