The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.1153 dated 21.10.2023 under Sections 25(1-B)(a) of Arms Act, 1959 registered at P.S. Sadar, Hisar, District Hisar, Haryana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 08.02.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from HC Vikram Submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 08.02.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 08.02.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
