1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.29 dated 25.02.2018, registered under Sections 457, 380 of IPC, at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, District Batala.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 20.01.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court and was admtted to interim bail.
3. Learned counsel for the State has also affirmed the said fact.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 20.01.2024, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail subject to furnishing his bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Court. The petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing and shall not absent from the trial Court proceedings, without prior permission of the trial Court.
